- -borne Pathogens, Confined Space, Emergency Action Plans, Lockout/Tagout, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Assessments and Hearing Conservation.
- · A review of employer's training programs
- An inspection of the facility(s)
- An inspection of equipment
- · A review of the employers documentation and record keeping

SHAPE encourages a well-rounded Safety and Health Program, that is working to achieve lower employee injuries and illnesses while providing for better employee morale and retention. the private and public sectors. In addition to agency and government officials, presenters also included design consultants, manufacturer representatives and Team EJP personnel.


